 - III. Identify one activity from your list that could be implemented as a new development project and briefly explain the economic and social benefits of that project.
- 02. Discuss the main components of a project proposal and explain the process of compiling a proposal for a development initiative.
- 03. Explain how to promote effective engagement of various stakeholders of a project and how stakeholder engagement can benefit the project.
- 04. Consider any short-term development project and discuss briefly all the activities, tasks and challenges related to different phases of project life cycle.
- 05. Discuss the relationship between risk mitigation in project management and project planning using appropriate examples.
