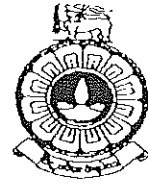

Question 01 (Compulsory question)

Ms. Tharundi Weeraratne, is a senior executive of a leading private sector organization. Tharundi's observation related with her organization reveals that employees' continuous grievances are not met and pre-mature turnover of employees, Customer complaints, Quality issues of products, dis-continuation of customer as well as supplier relationships and complain of sales agents on irregular payments of commissions.

She has observed that, leadership is a matter which significantly influence on job performance of employees. Therefore, she is interested in studying the impact of different leadership styles such as transformational leadership and transactional leadership styles on job performance of employees. Further, literature also indicates that, organizational commitment plays an important role in determining job performance of the employees. Accordingly previous researchers argue that leadership styles influence the organizational commitment of the employees and that in turn influence on employees job performance.
