- 03. Describe what is meant by "secondary sexual characteristics" giving two (02) suitable examples each for males and females.
- 04. List five (05) developmental tasks of adolescence identified by Robert Havighurst (1972).
- 05. Examine in brief **two (02)** characteristics of emotional development that takes place during adolescence.
- 06. "According to the Social Learning Approach by Albert Bandura, social interactions are an important factor that influences personality development."
 - Drawing on the principles of the Social Learning Approach, justify the above statement in relation to adolescents based on two (02) key points.
- 07. Analyse two (02) ways in which drug abuse could hinder the overall development of an adolescent.
- 08. Describe in brief two (02) social interests of adolescents.

 - i. Explain two (02) common emotional patterns in adolescents. (04 marks)

 - iii. Referring to at least **three (03)** key strategies, examine how the class teacher could help adolescents to solve their emotional problems. (10 marks)

- 10. "Becoming independent is a need arising from the cognitive development that takes place during adolescence."
 - i. Briefly analyse why it is important for adolescents to become independent.

- ii. Explain how the above need could lead to conflicts among adolescents and their parents, with special reference to the Sri Lankan context. (06 marks)
- iii. Highlighting three (03) key strategies, examine how parents could help adolescents become independent. (10 marks)
- 11. i. Explain the concept of "personality" citing an accepted definition. (04 marks)
 - ii. Briefly describe the relationship between an adolescent's "self-concept" and his/her personality. (06 marks)
 - iii. Discuss how the ideas put forward by Carl Rogers could be used by the school administration to facilitate the development of a wholesome self-concept in adolescents. (10 marks)
- 12. i. "Identifying adolescence as a special stage in the human lifespan is a relatively new social invention".
 - Explain in brief **two (02)** factors that have led to the identification of adolescence as a significant stage in human life. (04 marks)
 - ii. Compare the nature of ego-centrism present in an adolescent, and that in a child in his/her early childhood. (06 marks)
 - iii. a. State two (02) problems that ego-centrism can create in an adolescent.

- b. Examine how parents could help adolescents overcome **one (01)** of the problems that you mentioned under (a) above illustrating **two (02)** specific strategies that could be employed.
