- 2.1 Clinical Psychologists are trained in several clinical interview methods that assist them in different situations to gain an understanding regarding a client and their problems.
 - a) Describe three types of clinical interviews. (6 marks)
 - b) Describe three skills that an interviewer should possess. (3 marks)
 - c) Apart from the communication process, what are three other factors to consider when conducting a clinical interview? (6 marks)
- 2.2 Clinical Psychologists training includes an understanding of Psychotherapy from the early ages to modern day theories and techniques that are utilized in clinical practice.
 - a) Describe the concepts of Id, Ego and Superego. (6 marks)
 - b) Describe "The Unconscious" in Psychodynamic Psychotherapy. (3 marks)
 - c) In Person Centred therapy describe Roger's triad of "necessary and sufficient conditions". (6 marks)
- 2.3 In Behavior therapy Clinical Psychologists are introduced to the theories of Classical and Operant conditioning. Several, widely used therapeutic approaches stem from these two theories.
 - a) In Behaviour therapy, describe classical conditioning and two therapeutic approaches based on classical conditioning. (8 marks)
 - b) In Behaviour therapy, describe operant conditioning and one therapeutic approach based on operant conditioning. (7 marks)
