Identify and describe the major concepts and theoretical principles found in the works of **two** of the following: Amartya Sen, Denis Goulet, Dudley Seers, John Maynard Keynes and Raul Prebisch.
- 2. What were the procedures followed in national policy development and planning framework for the identification of development projects by the government of Sri Lanka during the period of 2000 2019?
- 3. Define Sri Lankan Country Safeguard System and its application in foreign funded projects to address adverse social and environmental impacts from project activities.
- 4. Define the process in a Project Cycle Management and identify its phases and key actions to be taken by the project proponent during each phase.
- 5. Identify the steps and four analytical tools used in the Design and Monitoring Framework (DMF) and provide few examples in real project situations.
- 6. Demonstrate how a range of techniques can be applied to conduct project feasibility studies and express your views on limitations of using each technique.
