- 4. Focusing on the work of Jurgen Habermas, discuss whether the public sphere exists in contemporary society. Elaborate your answer with examples from Sri Lankan society.
- 5. "Gendered division of labour exists to maintain the subordination of women in society". Discuss this statement using a feminist theoretical perspective.
- 6. Discuss with examples how structuralism and post-structuralism differ in their understanding of social structures to explain social phenomena.
