(Select any two from the following: floral, lines, geometric, animal prints)

- Effective use of graphite medium techniques to show shading, texture, and depth
- A well-composed, visually balanced, and neat drawing

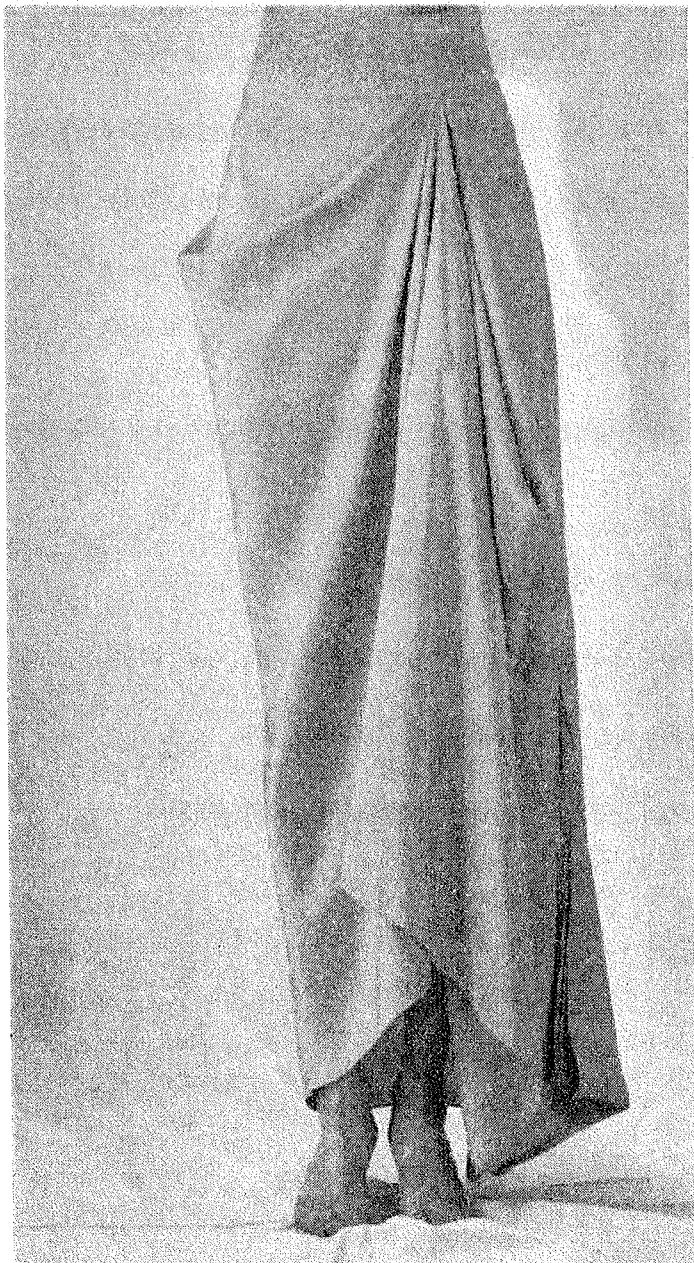

The illustration should demonstrate the following:

- Human figure development (8-head height) and proportion
- Figure details (hair, facial features, and makeup)
- Garment illustration (folds, creases, print pattern)
- Accessories (handbag, earrings, and high heels)
- Rendering techniques to show different fabric qualities and features
- Application of suitable background, proper composition, overall presentation, and creativity.
