 - (c) Marxist Perspective.

Explain in terms of the roles, functions, basic values, model and debates in social services.

- 8. Describe the different models of Social Work Practices.

- 9. Write short notes on any <u>three (03)</u> of the following:

 - (iii) Occupational welfare
 - (iv) Welfare targets for the mother and child
 - (v) Sri Lankan welfare model
 - (vi) The influence of party politics on social welfare policies in Sri Lanka
