- 2. What the Noble Eight Fold Path conveys, should be understood with sufficient spiritual depth if there is to be a qualitative difference in the behaviour of those who believe. Discuss.
- 3. A culture that is anti-establishment should not be considered harmful to society. Critically discuss.
- 4. Modernization does not mean total elimination of the way of life of traditional people or imposing the will of the majority on minority groups. Discuss.
- 5. Explain the significance of some of the scholarly perspectives of culture that help us to understand our society better.
- 6. Christianity as a way of life relates to the need to accept Gods plan and purpose as what is best for man. Explain what this means.
- 7. Explain the standards set by the Qur'an concerning the obligations of husbands and wives with regard to children, inheritance and divorce. Discuss.
