- 3. Explain the rationale behind the three models of development communication you have studied.
- 4. Scholars have criticized the application of the diffusion concept as a development strategy because it is inherently pro-innovation biased as well as pro-individual biased. Discuss.
- 5. What is social marketing? Explain the concept with relevant concepts and suitable examples.
- 6. Discuss the significance of agricultural extension in modernizing the farming industry, with reference to problems connected with conventional extension systems in agricultural communication.
- 7. Use of new communication technology is a must for national development. Discuss.
- 8. Popular participation in development is best perceived as transactional communication. Explain the concept using a development project in Sri Lanka.
- 9. Write short notes on the following:
 - (a) The Fogo process.
 - (b) Decentralized development administration.
 - (c) Audience based message design.
 - (d) New World Information and Communication Order.
