- 4. The function of the critic has existed for centuries, but it is relatively recent as a job. Explain the potential of this role critically.
- 5. Playwrights often write many drafts of a play, both before and after it enters production. Explain the features of this process.
- 6. Comedy has a range of subgenres that can be understood along a spectrum from high comedy to low comedy. Explain what they are.
- 7. Discuss the key elements of Brecht's concept of epic theatre with reference to structure, staging and acting effect.
- 8. Art films are not governed to the same degree by commercial imperatives to provide entertainment and pleasure. Discuss how these films differ from the mainstream productions.
- 9. Explain what 'cinematography' refers to with reference to five major features.
