- 3. Discuss the similarities and dissimilarities of the characteristics of Portuguese rule and Dutch rule in the regions under their control during their tenures in Sri Lanka.

- 4. Explain the evolution of the Kandyan Dynasty since the inception of the Kandyan Kingdom with special reference to the steps taken by each king to secure the Kingdom from three foreign invaders since 1505.
- 5. It is a well established fact that up to the beginning of the 16<sup>th</sup> century, Sri Lanka possessed a self sufficient economic system. Explain the characteristics of this system with examples
- 6. (a) Explain the reasons behind the upcountry riots in 1818 and 1848, and,
