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

- 03. What do you mean by a 'responsive public administration'? Discuss briefly roles of the key stakeholders of this process in a democratic system of government.
- 04. Identify functions of general management by using any conceptual model you are familiar with. Discuss two of them in detail.
- 05. How do you distinguish project monitoring from project evaluation? Describe basic principles for developing a monitoring plan.
- 06. Privatization of public enterprises is not a viable option under the policy agenda of the present government of Sri Lanka. In view of this development examine the ways and means of improving productivity of these public sector enterprises.
- 07. Enumerate salient aspects of the Traditional Career Service Model of the public service. Examine the need for modification of that model in the present context drawing examples from the Sri Lankan public services.

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
