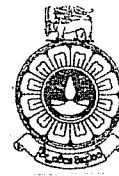

Q1).

- i. Although Bevin and his team completed a quality software product on time, the top management was disappointed with them because Bevin did not focus on managing all aspects of the project. He never provided them with accurate schedules or detailed plans of what was happening. Instead of performing the work of the project manager, Bevin had taken on the role of software integrator and troubleshooter. Bevin, however, did not understand the top management's concerns.

 - b. As a student of IT project management course, how would you explain the top management's concerns to Bevin?
- ii. Project charter is a vital document used in project management.
 - a. List the contents of a project charter.
 - b. Discuss how project managers can use it for effective project management.
- iii. Assume there is a change in the list of requirements in a software project. Briefly explain how you are going to handle it as a project manager.
