- II. As a youth development worker explain how you could develop participatory or experiential learning situations for youths you will be working with.

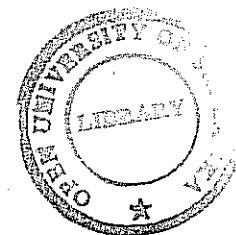
